TWIGGS COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPERINTENDENT SELECTION PROCESS

JEFFERSONVILLE, GA – Twiggs County Board of Education began the official search for a new Superintendent of Schools in the Fall of 2020. The Board enlisted the services of the Georgia School Board Association (GSBA) to guide the process. GSBA is a member of the National Affiliation of Superintendent Searchers (NASS). GSBA uses a 17-step search process, providing turnkey services and supporting the local Board in maintaining legal compliance and best practice selection techniques as they move through the selection process.

Among the steps completed in the process, the Board adopted qualifications for the position; approved and disseminated a recruitment brochure; reviewed applications; and interviewed candidates that most closely met the qualifications. The Board received forty-four applications from a broad range of applicants.

At least 14 calendar days before final action on the position, the Board is required to provide public access to the documents of as many as three persons determined to be best qualified for the office.

During a called Board meeting on Thursday, February 18, 2021, Dr. Mack Bullard was named by the Twiggs County Board of Education as the best-qualified candidate for the position, thus becoming the sole finalist for Superintendent of Schools. The Board will seat the new superintendent by April 1, 2021.
